Together, T.E.A.C.H. and INCENTIVE\$ help to educate, retain, and provide additional support for our state's early learning workforce. These programs along with other quality initiatives, help foster more stable relationships and positive outcomes for young children.

Hey, INCENTIVE\$ participants! Did you know you could have the majority of your tuition covered, receive reimbursements for books or a new computer, and have access to a dedicated Counselor to help you along the way by becoming a T.E.A.C.H. scholar?

T.E.A.C.H. can also help INCENTIVE\$ participants meet their continuing education requirement with its 3-6 Hour Credit Scholarship Model (for INCENTIVE\$ Scale levels 1 to 4).

T.E.A.C.H. RESPONSIBILITY:



80% tuition and 90% books

Paid release time reimbursement for 3 hours/week (to the sponsor)*

\$250 student access stipend <u>and</u> \$500 bonus following completion of the **T.E.A.C.H.** contract (to the scholar)

SCHOLAR RESPONSIBILITY:

10% tuition and 10% books

Minimum 6-month work commitment to the sponsor following completion of the T.E.A.C.H. contract

*Paid release time = Florida minimum wage + \$2.00 per hour.

Release time gives scholars dedicated and guaranteed time for their studies. T.E.A.C.H. reimbursement makes this essential scholarship component of <u>little to no cost</u> for the sponsor.

To retain program eligibility, center-based educators must satisfy the requirement every two years; family child care educators every three years.
